Welcome to the north western part of Fjord Norway

The trip is designed for 2 persons either as a self drive or with car/driver. We aim to add the highlights of the region and to spend time to enjoy the scenery and lower the shoulders as they travel. If preferred this idea can be redesigned to have fewer accomodations spot and rather do day trips.

Day 1:

Arrival Ålesund Airport. Pick up car, proceed to Sagafjord Hotel in Sæbø, Hjørundfjord.

- ✓ Check in at Sagafjord Hotel-by Classic Norway, Hotel Union Øye or Rekkedal Landscape rooms

at Trandal Village

Exciting History

Christian Gaard Bygdetun is idyllically located by the Hjørundfjord in the small village of Trandal in Ørsta municipality. The place has a long history filled with both drama and humor. It is run by the Storeide family, and guests are welcome to ask the hosts about the fascinating stories of the estate when visiting.

How to get there

There is no road connection to Trandal, so you'll need to travel by ferry from Ytre Standal or Sæbø, by shuttle boat, or by the public boat that runs in summer between Ålesund, Trandal, Sæbø, Urke, and Øye. Christian Gaard Bygdetun also offers several shuttle boats of various sizes, available for both short trips in the local area or longer journeys along the coast, including to Ålesund.









Day 3 Hjørundfjord-Geiranger

Up up and away! After breakfast it's time to continue our journey along the fjords and hidden gems. A short carferry ride form Sæbø to Leknes will take us towards Øye and the scenic drive through Norangdal. Our first suggested stop is to do a hike (short or long) in Urke. This can be mount Saksa or Urke ridge, (use google translate on this) or a shorter version to Bentebu, one of two mountain shelters in he village.


On the way from Urke to Hellsylt you pass the distinct Hotel Union Øye and of course you can plan your drive and include a lunch at the hotel. (must be prebooked)

While driving through the valley make sure to find time to stop at lake <u>Lygnstøylsvatnet</u> and Stavbergsetra.









After driving through the Nordangsdal Valley and the Queens route it's time to prepaire a visit to one of Norways most iconic destinastions, the UNESCO Geirangerfjord.

A car ferry will take your from the village of Hellesylt to Geiranger (all-year car ferry bookable via an agreement with Norways Best)

The Geirangerfjord is a 15-kilometre-long branch of Stofjord and has been inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List. The Geirangerfjord is one of Norway's most popular attractions and offers a spectacular introduction to this iconic Norwegian geographical feature. On the 50 minute sailing you can choose to download an audioguide or listen to the onboard guiding (summer)

Once arriving in Geiranger there are severeal options for activities.

- ☐ Boat tour and hike to one of the Fjord Farms (can be curated with private guide from Offbeat Adventures)
- □ <u>Visit to Møll</u>, a farm inhabited from the medieval time and where Anette and Willy still welcomes guests to their home.
- ☐ Drive to <u>Dalsnibba Viewpoint</u>
- □ Kayak the fjord
- ☐ Lunch or dinner at Westerås Farm

Drive via the National Scenic Route to Valldal (road + ferry)

The national scenic route

Geiranger to Valldal

The National Scenic routes are parts of our regular roads that represents natural beauty and that in some parts has been empahsized with architectural features. For this region the road starts close to Dalsnibba in Geiranger and stretches over the Trollstigen Road to Åndalsnes, and then the Atlantic Road.

I suggest that if your guests do not prefer to stay overnight in Geiranger (summer can be quite hectic in there, shoulder and winter seasons a completely different case) to rather travel to Valldal.

A very scenic drive where the first stop could be at <u>Ørnesvingen/The eagle road</u> and perhaps the second at lake Eidsvatnet (photo)


Take the car ferry from Eidsdal to Linge and drive towards Valldal for your overnight stay. Choose between:

Day 4 (5) Valldal-Åndalsnes

<u>Part 2 of the National Scenic route</u> takes you from Valldal via Trollstigen to Åndalsnes.

Stop at <u>Gudbrandsjuvet</u> and the <u>Trollstigen Viewpoint</u> before driving down the hairpin roads towards Åndalsnes. The driving time is about 90 minutes from Valldal and over the mountain. Please note that this part of the road is a summer road and opening times are dependant on snow conditions. I therefor add an optional route.

Optional road map Valldal-Sjøholt-Åndalsnes

Drive from Valldal along the scenic Storfjorden to Sjøholt. Suggest to stop in Sjøholt and go on a guided tour or ebike tour with Offbeat Adventures. They will give you options depending on your clients.

Continue along the fjords to Åndalsnes and check in at your hotel.

We suggest <u>Grand Hotel-by Classic Norway Hotels</u> or <u>Hotel Aak.</u>

Day 5 (6) Åndalsnes-Angvik

Choose 1 or 2 nights in Åndalsnes before starting the next part of the journey from Åndalsnes to Angvik.

I highly recommend you to make a detour and stop on the way to Eikesdal and <u>Mardalsfossen</u> (open June 20th to August 20th), northern Europe's highest waterfall before arriving in Angvik Gamle Handelssted-your accomodation for the next days. (<u>map</u>)

Once arriving at the hotel there are plenty of options to relax and enjoy the Badehuset spa, which offers a heated bath, or the Turkish steam bath as well as various types of treatment. In the museum Handelshuset Angvik, located in the old "Gustavbua", there is cultural history dating back to the Dutch era in the 16th century.

- ☐ Fishing rods available for free. Try your luck from the dock or borrow one of the boats.
- ☐ The hotel offers bicycles for free. Helmets are included. Set out on a pleasant ride on the nearby roads. There is little traffic.

☐ Angvik as a base by car:

- Drive/walk to Innerdalen, also known as "Norway's most beautiful valley."
- Round trip by car to Eikesdalen, Mardalsfossen, Aursjøvegen, and Sunndal.
- Trip to Romsdalseggen, Trollveggen, and Trollstigen.
- Round trip to Kristiansund, Atlantic Road, and Molde.
- Summit hike to Kirketaket, Ekkertind, Prestaksla and a paradise of other peaks in the vicinity.









Day 7 (8) Angvika-Kristiansund-Håholmen

If time allows it we'd recommend to visit the little fishing village of <u>Grip</u>. There is a boat departure at 10 in the morning from the end of May to Sep 1.

Upon return there is an option to have lunch at <u>Bryggekanten brasserie</u>, and as simple as it sounds,- the recommendation is fish and chips!

It's adviced to rest or take a slow stroll after this lunch, or perhaps just jump onboard the «Sundbåten», the little passenger boat travelling in between the islands Kristiansund is located. This little boat is nothing less than the worlds oldest, still operating, public transport!

Once your little stop in Kristiansund is over it's time to move towards the Atlantic Road and Håholmen. Please note that you will be asked for arrival time when booking Håholmen or the villa at Korsholmen as there are no road connection to the islands.









The Atlantic Road

– part of the National Scenic Route

Named the world's most beautiful road trip

This iconic stretch is a national scenic route where nature's forces and engineering blend into an unforgettable driving experience close to the sea. Completed in 1989 after a construction period that endured 12 hurricanes, the road takes you through the contrasts of the coastal landscape – from the open seas to sheltered coves and historic fishing villages. The journey between Bud and Kristiansund is a cohesive experience of coast, culture, and history. In 2005, the Atlantic Road was voted the construction of the century in the 20th century.



Day 8 (9) Continue on the Atlantic Road

The spectacular viewpoints

Along the Atlantic Road, you will find the <u>Svevestien trail</u> on <u>Eldhusøya</u>, a path that "hovers" above the terrain and offers views of the open ocean, perfect for a break and panoramic views. Be sure to visit <u>Askevågen</u>, where a rugged viewing platform made of untreated steel provides a raw encounter with the forces of nature. This is more than just a drive – here you can stop and explore on foot, by bike, or try your luck fishing in some of Norway's most bountiful waters. And for the adventurous: surfing in the waves of the Atlantic Ocean is an experience that leaves its mark.

Continue to the village of Bud, and look deeper into activities to enhance your experiences along the Atlantic Road in this article









...and onwards

Leaving Bud and the Atlantic Road could have led you to Molde for a visit, but this time we have chosen to go coastal and continue to the island of Finnøy.

The island of Finnøy on the Romsdal coast was originally pasture for the farmers on Sandøya. The facility that is today Finnøy Bryggehotell was originally established with a shop, shipping trade and fish reception on an islet (Holmen) by Finnøya. In the premises that are now restaurants and meeting rooms, cuttlefish and salted herring were produced.


On Finnøya, Nils Finnøy established himself as the first permanent resident. He established a mechanical workshop on Finnøya, and he built the first Norwegian-built boat engine – the Finnøy engine – in 1902. This was the start of a new era with motorized fishing boats and the introduction of modern fishing activities.

Please note that from Bud to Finnøy there are three car ferries. The first from Aukra to Hollingsholmen, the second from Småge to Orta, and the third from Orta to Finnøy. Check the schedules as they may vary.









The Northern Islands

Ona, Finnøy, Harøy, Fjørtoft, Longva, Haramsøy, Lepsøy

What are these islands?

A string of large and small islands that extend north from Ålesund towards the Romsdalsfjord. Some of these islands are connected to the mainland by bridges and tunnels, while others can only be reached by boat and ferry, like the little island of Ona or Sandøy. The coast of Sunnmøre has a rich fisheries and industrial history. Agriculture and shipbuilding are the biggest industries.

The people who have lived on these islands have always used the sea to get around, but the new Nordøyvegen road now links many of them to the mainland by bridges and tunnels, while others still use boat services to the other islands and to Ålesund.



Day 11 (12) Via the Nordøy road to Ålesund

After the island adventure it's time to move on to Ålesund and spend a couple of days in the Art Nouveau/Jugend style town.

Enjoy the drive over the spectacular Nordøy road with bridges and tunnels, and look out for wildlife like eagles and seals that at times are facinatingly close to the road.

Once arrived in Ålesund you can safely park you car and even plan to return a rented car as the town is easy to walk around and well connected with public transport.

Enjoy one of the many restaurants and bars, take a stroll in the streets and take in the architecture. Buy fresh prawns from the local fishing boats and enjoy lunch «al fresco» on a bench or in the park (just wrap up the waste so the seagulls don't feast on them!)

Extra time? Do a fjord cruise, rent a bike, book time in the saunas, do a Via Ferrata, visit a gallery, og fishing, visit the Atlanterhavsparken Aquarium or the Art Nouveau center, take the bus to Sunnmøre Museum, try Coasteering or travel to Runde to look for the puffins in the summer.
